



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 Acres dated the 21st day of April 1794 granted to John Tibbs, was surveyed on the twenty eighth day of June 1823, the above described tract of land, containing 429 acres 57 perches and allowance of six per cent. for roads 46. Situate in Beaver township Crawford county and at the time of surveying the same Thomas Foster was residing there on, and there were more than fifty acres cleared on the same.
