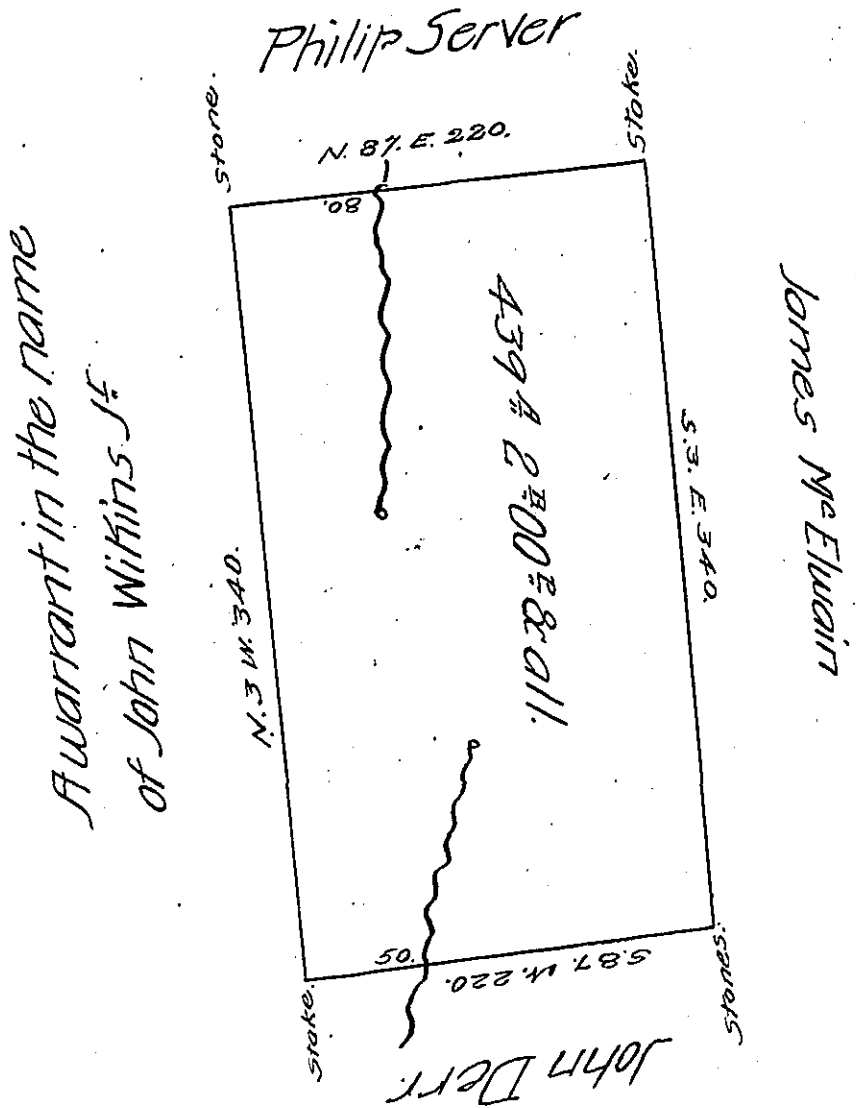

of John Wilkins Jr

A Draught of a Survey executed October 3^d 1825 for Felix Neigley by virtue of an improvement purchased from Benjamin Serter dated September 1796 Situate in Pine Township Allegheny County on the waters of Pine Creek Containing four hundred & thirty nine acres two Rods & allowance of Six p^{ts} of 6^{ths} for Roads &c. Note at the time of executing the Survey Jacob Stoop (a purchase of part of said tract) was residing on said tract and engaged in improving the same.
