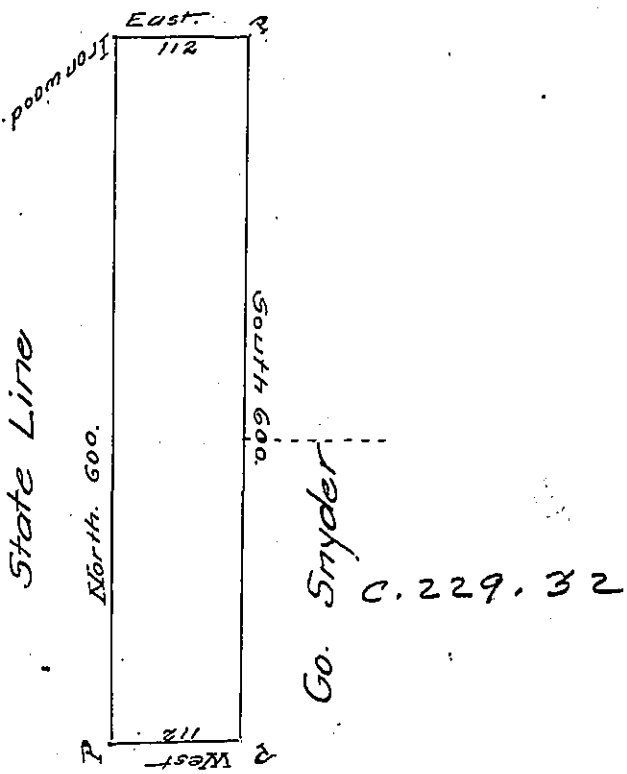

The above is the draught of a survey made March 12th 1794. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Henry Snyder on the 14th day of April 1792. situate Northwest of the Ohio river on the Waters of Beaver Creek — adjoining land granted to George Snyder — called Hall — containing 408 Acres & 112 perches with the usual allowance of 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent &c.
