



The above is the draught of a survey made March 12<sup>th</sup> 1795  
 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Robert Smith Merch<sup>t</sup> on the  
 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792 situate Northwest<sup>2</sup> of the Ohio river on the  
 Waters of  
 Little Beaver Creek adjoining land granted to John Smith & Robt<sup>t</sup>  
 Smith Merch<sup>t</sup> called Muddy Bank containing 417 Acres and 32  
 perches with the usual allowance of 6 p. Cent & -
