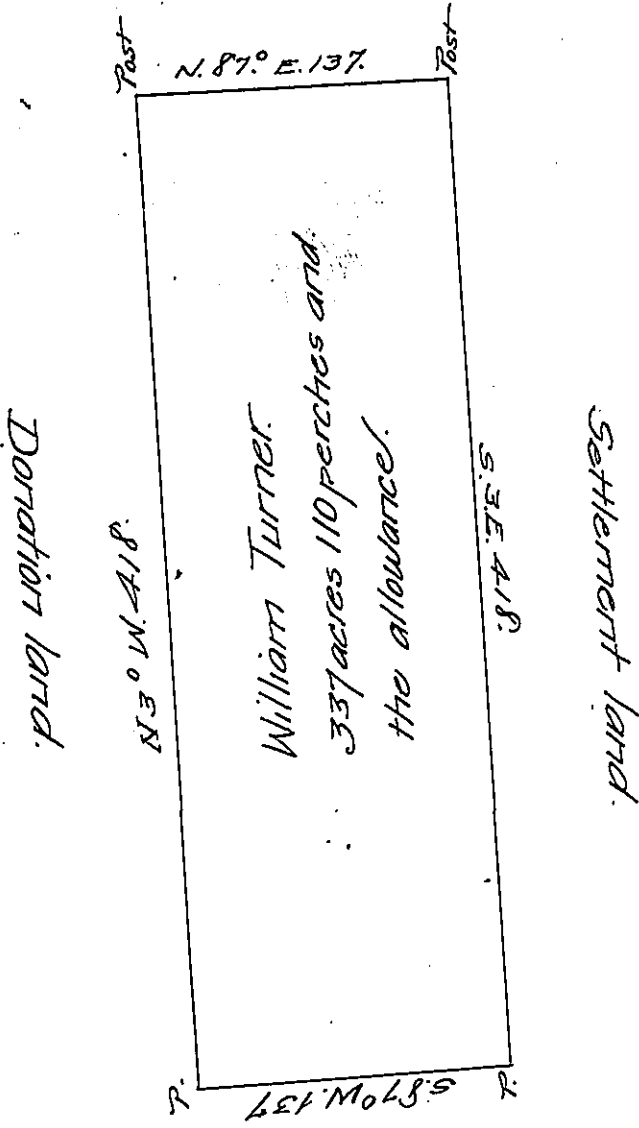


William Gibson
