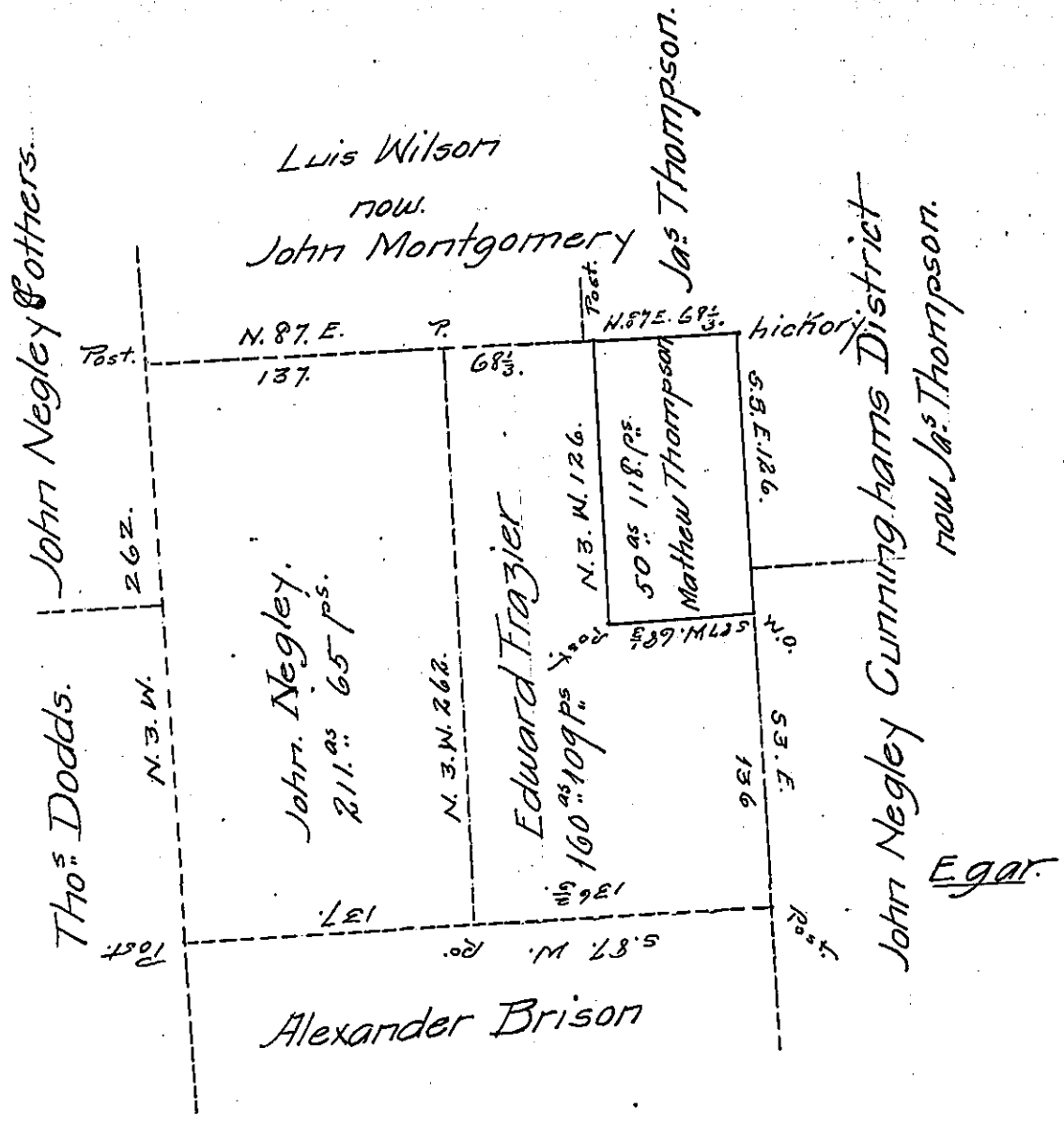

A Draught of a part of a ~~tract~~ tract of land containing 50^{ac} 118^{ps} Situate in Center Township Butler Co. Pa. on the waters of Little Cannoqueness Creek - being parts of a larger tract now claimed by John Negley & Edward Frazier as marked by the dotted lines containing in all 422^{ac} 130^{ps} and by the parts as marked in the above Draught. Surveyed May 1st 1819 on a Warrant granted Matthew Thompson containing Fifty acres dated 22nd day of March AD. 1819.
