



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 Acres dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April 1794 granted George Scott, was Surveyed on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of October 1830 the above described tract of land containing 404 Acres 90 perches and allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. Situate in Summerhill township in Crawford County (It being the same tract of land which was Surveyed on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of May 1795 in the name of James Elliot in pursuance of his alledged improvement bearing date the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 1795)
