



Situate in Monroe township Bedford County containing 144 acres 67 perches

and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Being composed of one tract containing 26 as. 67 ps. &c. Surveyed the 19th of April 1852 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Snyder for 24 as. dated the 7th of April 1852; and 118 acres and allowance, being part of a tract that (it was said) contained \* 100 as. &c. Surveyed the 10th of November 1824 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Nicholas Border for 30 acres, dated the 14th of June 1824, Returned the 15th of July 1852.
