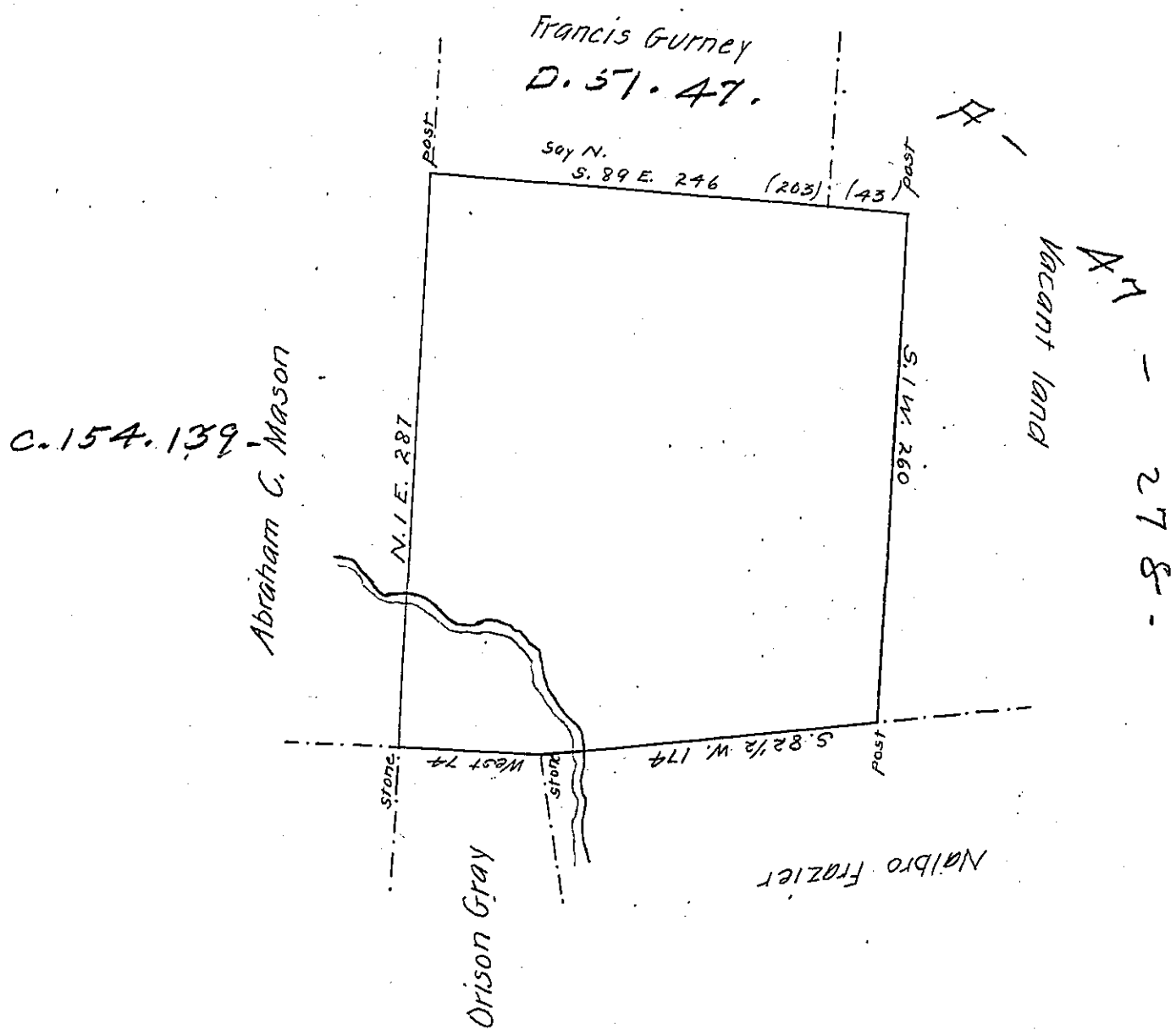

By virtue of a Warrant dated July 13<sup>th</sup> 1793 and order of survey received September 6<sup>th</sup> 1850 Surveyed September 26<sup>th</sup> 1850 to Daniel Smith the above described Tract of land Situate in Palmyra Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County adjoining land Surveyed To Francis Gurney Containing four hundred and one acres one hundred and twenty eight perches and the allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c
