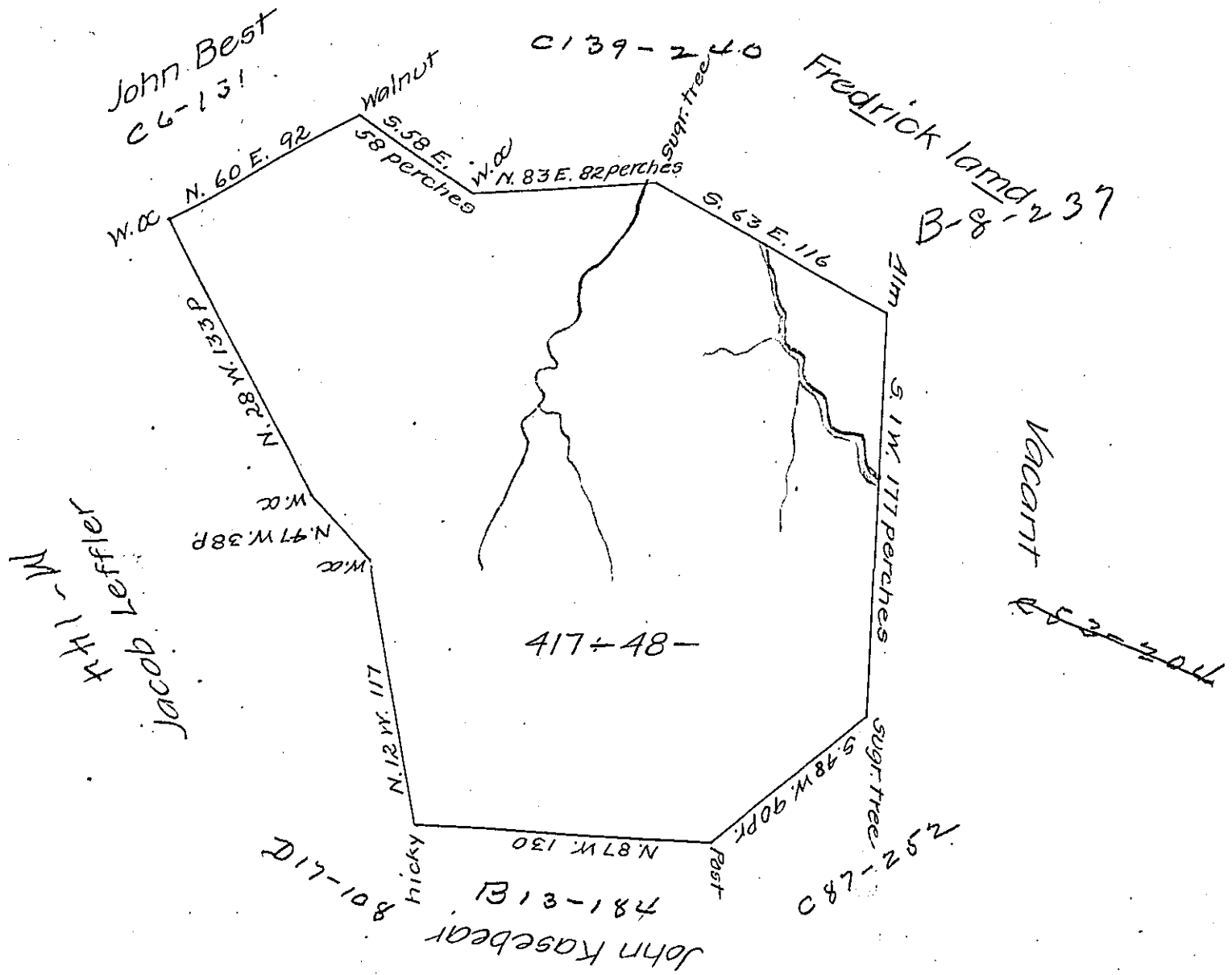

We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented lands in the  
 Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Christian  
 Wyan is Entitled to four hundred acres of Land in the County of Ohio on  
 Buffaloe Creek to include his actual Settlement made in the year one thousand  
 seven hundred & seventy four Given Under our hands at Coxes for the  
 Eighteenth day of February 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
