 Yohag<sup>9</sup> & Ohio do hereby Certify that Thomas Waller is Intitled to four  
 Hundred acres of Land in the County of Ohio on the Waters of Buffaloe  
 Creek to Include his actual Settlement made in the year one thousand  
 Seven Hundred & Seventy five and also Right In-preemption to one thousand  
 acres adjoining thereunto Given under our hand at Coxes fort the 22 day  
 of Feby. 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
