



Situate on the waters of Dunnings creek in the township and county of Bedford, containing 178 acres 105 perches and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Being composed of three tracts, Surveyed on three warrants as follows, Viz- Henry Stiffer containing 130 as. 21 ps. Surveyed the 2nd of April 1787 & resurveyed the 22nd of April 1846, on a warrant

granted in the name of Henry Stiffler for 60 acres dated the 21st of December 1785- Henry Wiant, containing 35 acres, Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of said Henry Wiant, dated the 12th of June 1794 -

And Henry Stiffer containing 13 1/2 acres surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Henry Stiffler for 10 acres dated the 8th of July 1794. Connected from and carefully compared with office drafts the 19th of Novr. 1851. Returned for patenting to Henry Stiffer the 25th of Nov. 1851.
