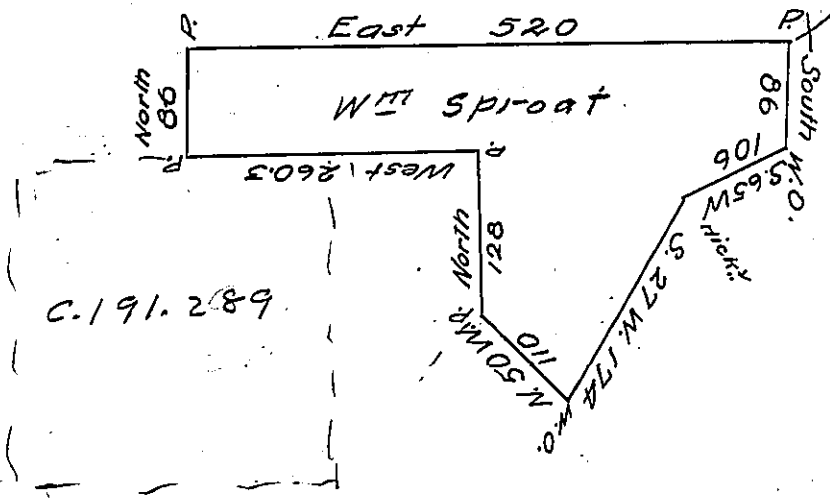


John Sproat

The above is a draught of a survey made March 11<sup>th</sup> 1795 in pursuance of a warrant granted to William Sproat on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792 Situate Northwest of the Ohio river on the Waters of Beaver Creek - adjoining land granted to John Sproat called Judenberg containing 396 acres and 112 perches with the usual allowance of 6 p. Cent &c.
