



Situate on the waters of Stoneycreek and Franks Town Branch, on the top of Allegheny Mountain, in Allegheny Township, Somerset (formerly Bedford) County Pa containing eighty Seven and a quarter Acres and allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed on the 20th 21st & 22nd days of September 1860 by H.L. Holbrook in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Stiner for one hundred Acres dated September 7th A.D. 1793.
