



In pursuance of his actual Settlement was Surveyed for Peter Gilson on the ninth day of August Eighteen hundred & twenty two, the above Described Tract of land, containing Four hundred forty one acres and one hundred & fifty perches, and allowance of Six per cent for roads & c. Situate in Oil Creek township Crawford county; and at the time of Surveying the Same Peter Gilson was residing thereon, (and Benj<sup>e</sup> Gilson) and there was an improvement of more than twenty acres on the Same which was commenced in 1801.
