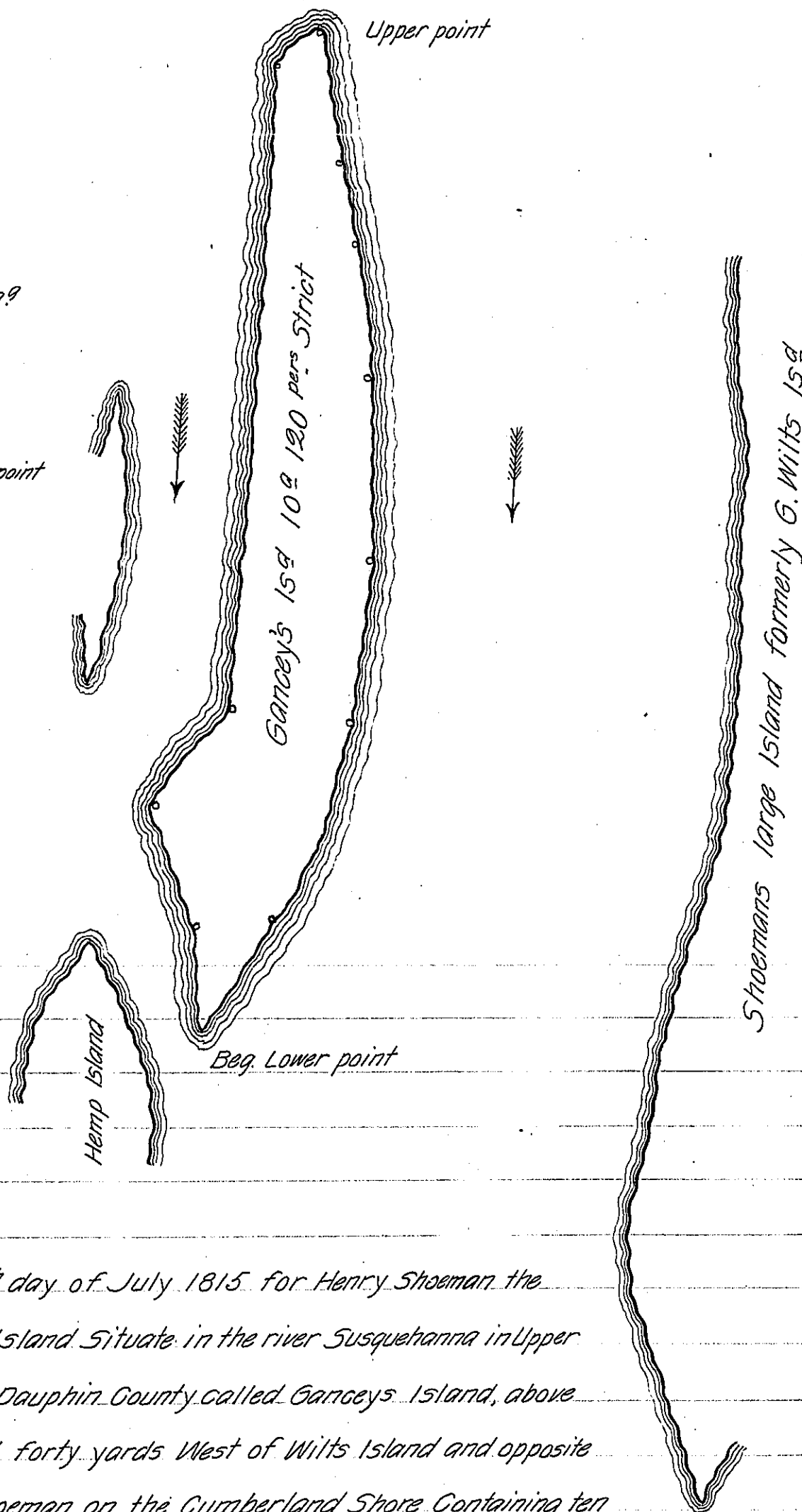

Surveyed the 7th day of July 1815 for Henry Shoeman the above described Island Situate in the river Susquehanna in Upper Paxton Township Dauphin County called Ganceys Island, above Hemp Island and forty yards West of Wilts Island and opposite land of Said Shoeman on the Cumberland Shore Containing ten Acres One hundred & twenty perches Strict Measure by his Warrant of the 5th of July 1815.
