



By Virtue of A Warrant dated the 11th of February 1794 Surveyed to Peter Snyder the 6th of October 1796 by Anthony Crothers, Esq^r the Above described tract of Land Situate on a Creek emptying into Susquehanna— at the Great Bend, in Northampton County (now Wayne County) containing two hundred and eight acres and one hundred and forty seven perches, and the Allowance of Six Per Cent & C.
