



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Springfield Township in the County of Bucks, in the State of Pennsylvania Containing Twenty Acres and 17 Perches of Land and the Usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads, That formerly was Surveyed (Supposed by Edward Scull.) by Virtue of a Warrant dated on the 14<sup>th</sup> December Anno-1751. Granted by the Late Proprietaries to Peter Short, Who afterwards Sold his Right to the Same To others Till at Last the Same was Sold to Jacob Erdman. The present Possessor thereof To whom it was resurveyed By order of the Surveyor General, on the 15<sup>th</sup> December, Anno-1788.
