



In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Stephen Watts & Francis his Wife dated the 22^d day of June 1774. Requiring me to Re-Survey for the said Watts & Wife a certain Lot of Ground formerly Surveyed for Michael Walton (new Purchaser). I do Certify that I did on the 13th of August 1774. Re-Survey the said Lot of Ground, & find it to be Situate on the South side of Mulberry, or Arch Street in the City of Philad^a. between Schuylkill front Street & Second Streets, Containing in Breadth North and South on the East side of Schuylkill Front Street 102 feet, and in Length East & West on the South side of Mulberry or Arch Street 396 feet. Bounded Westward by Schuylkill Front Street, Northward by Mulberry or Arch Street. Eastward by Schuylkill Second Street, & Southward by other Ground of said Watts & Wife.
