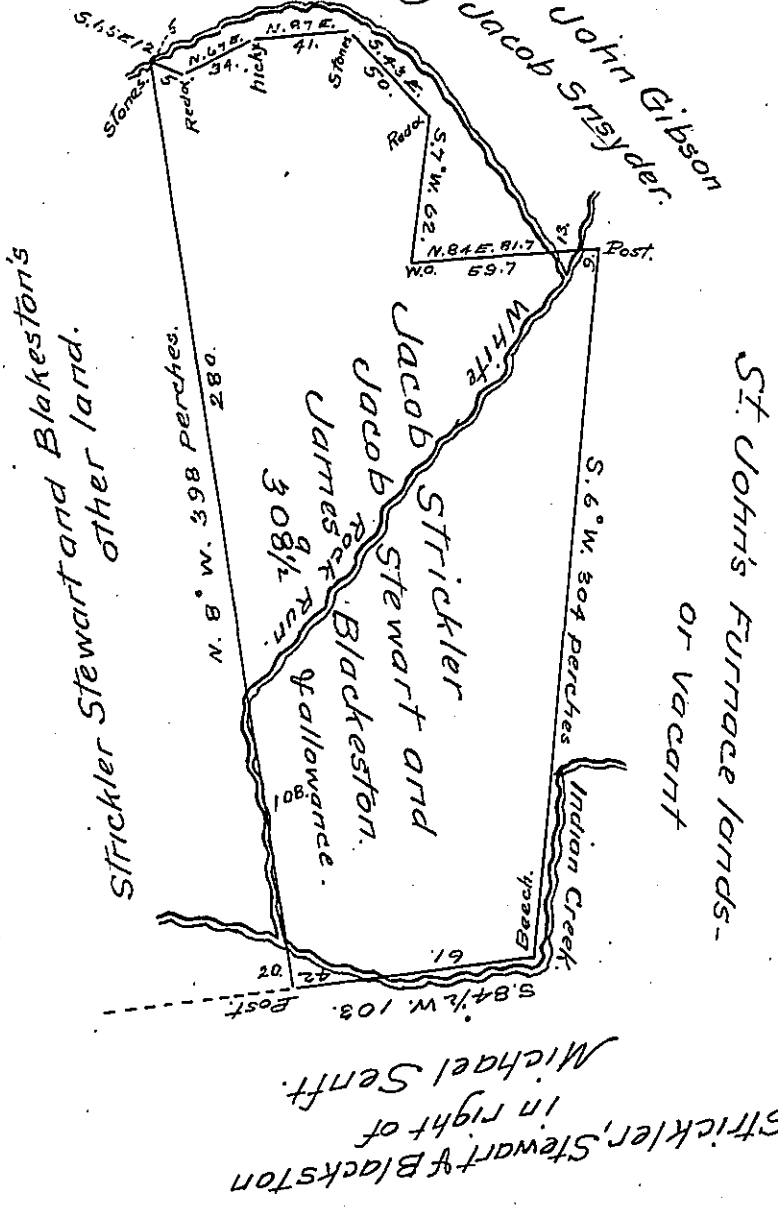


Lands said to belong to John Gibson
