



In pursuance of a warrant dated December seventeenth A.D. 1829 surveyed to Christian Smathers the above described tract of land on the 26th of April A.D. 1830 containing one hundred and sixty seven acres forty six perches and the allowance of six P. Ct. &c. situate in Clarion township Armstrong County bounded by lands originally surveyed to Alexander Brown lands of Robert Henry Senr. Geo. Smathers Michael Haregar Nicholas Polyard (N Balliot P the warrant) and lands of Nicholas Shirey (being a part of the survey of Alexander Brown) as represented by the draught
