Hulme. it is not dated nor can I learn when it was made but it is the land described (No. 57. of list No. 2) in his location No. 3587. of 3<sup>d</sup> July 1769 Moses Hall lived many years and I believe died on this land it is in Herry Clay formerly Wheeling Township or "Halls run" now occupied by Squire Hall and owned by Andrew Stewart Esq. of Uniontown and in part claimed by
