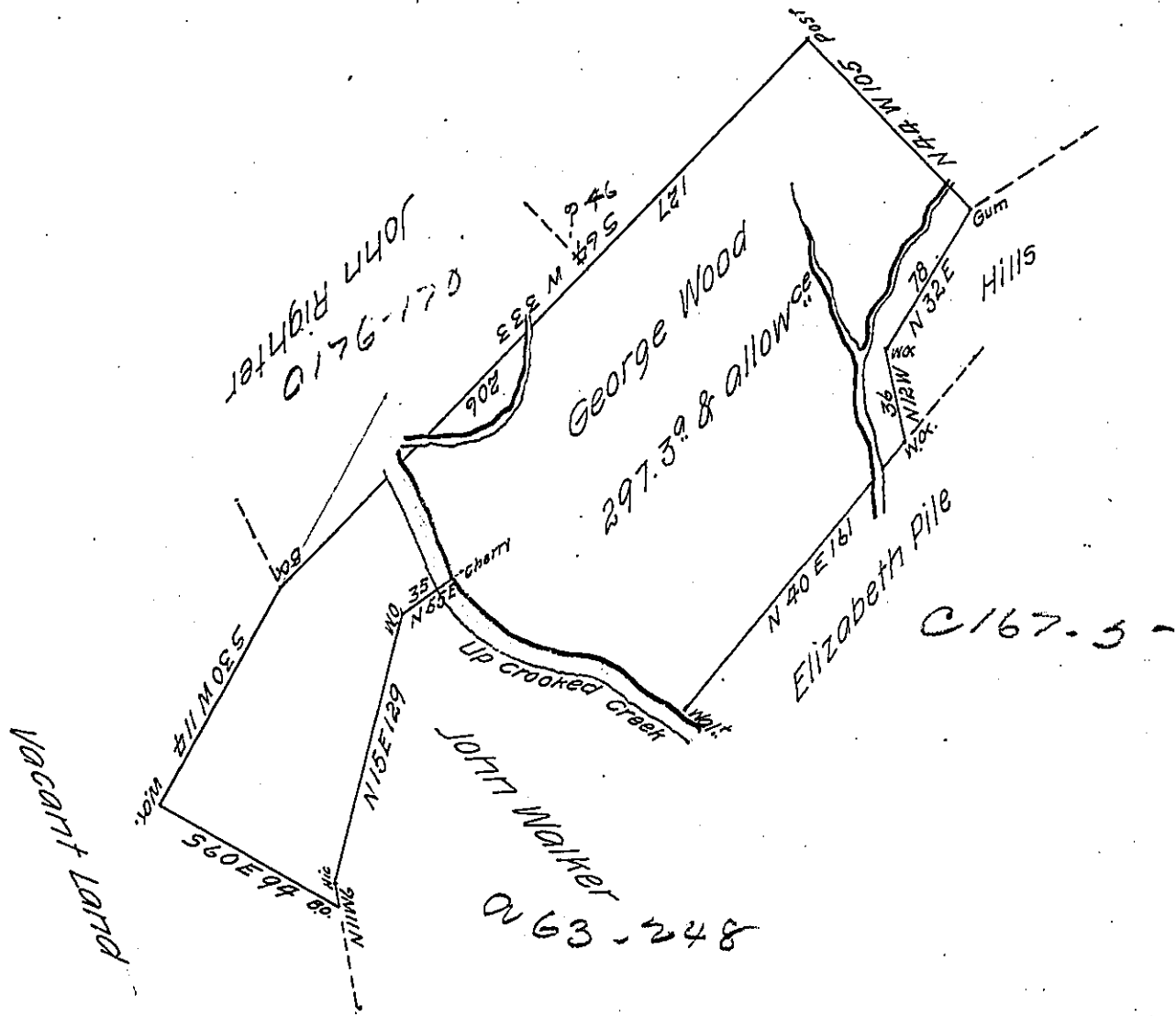


John Levering
