



A draught of a tract of land called—situate on the east side of the north east branch of Susquehanna River including the head waters of a small brook that empties into said river near Nescopeck adjoining land surveyed for Walter Stewart & Thomas Say in the County of Northumberland containing two hundred & ninety four acres & three quarters of an acre besides the usual allowance of 6 Per cent for roads &c surveyed the 17th day of November 1773 for Wm Webb in pursuance of a warrant dated the 6th day of Sept. 1773 To JOHN LUKERS Esq. by Chas Stewart D^y SUR^t Survey^r Gen^l.
