



A draught of a tract of land situate in Frederick Town-
 -ship in the County [obl] delphia and Province of Pennsylvania
 containing [obl] Acres and 13 perches of land together with
 the usual allowance at six per cent for roads that formerly was
 surveyed to Jacob Whiteman (alias Wightman) in pursuance
 of a warrant or ticket granted him by the Honble Proprieta-
 -ries dated on the 11th March Anno 17⁶⁸ after the said Jacob
 Whitemans death all his land or right to the same was by
 authority of the Orphans Court conveyed to his eldest son
 Andrew Whiteman who now again sold the above to his
 [obl] other George Whiteman surveyed for him on the 26th
 November 1768
