



Surveyed the above described tract of land on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one for Mark Schlonecker in pursuance of his warrant the 18<sup>th</sup> day of November (1830) for 400<sup>ac</sup> situate in Chapman township Lycoming County on the waters of Hiners run containing four hundred one acres and forty eight perches and allowance of six per cent for roads.
