



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the fifth day of Feb<sup>r</sup> 1733. Surveyed unto Adam Widner a tract of land situate in Oley in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup>. Beginning at a post <sup>in</sup> the Line of John Hoy's land thence by the same sixty four perches and by Vac<sup>t</sup> Land the same Course Thirty Six perches to a Beech Tree thence by Vacant Land South East Eighty-five perches to a White Oak thence by Vacant Land South West One hundred perches to a post in the line of his other land thence by the same North West Eighty five perches to the place of Beginning. Containing Fifty acres with ye usual allowance of six p Cent
