

A Warrant was granted to David Meichter for about 100^a adjoining his other
Land (formerly surveyed to Ulrich Englehort) w^{ch} he purchased said
Warrt was dated the 3^d of 9^{ber} 1736, sent for by D. Meichter at the req-
uest of Melchior Weignar but D. M. took it out in his own name.

David Meichters Warrt made void & another granted to Melchior
Weignar the 15th of 8^{ber} 1740. To make a return &c. for M. Weignar
