



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the twentieth day of September 1734. Surveyed unto Samuel Walton a Tract of Land situate on a branch of Tohickon called Three Mile Run in the County of Bucks. Beginning at a post on the bank of the said Run about Six feet East from a White Oak mark^t. thence by land of James Dicken North West One hundred and Sixty^{Seven} perches to a White Oak a Corner of 5^d Dickens Land. thence by Vacant land North East One hundred and Thirty six perches to a post. thence in a line of Adam Scheffers land. thence by that and land of Peter Partridge South East One hundred and Eighty seven perches to a post on the bank of 5^d Run. thence up the same to the place of Beginning. Containing One hundred and fifty acres with the usual allowance of Six p Cent
