



By Virtue of a warrant from the Honble Proprietaries bearing date the 10th day of December Anno Dom: 1739 Surveyed to Henry White a tract of land in Donegal Township & County of Lancaster Beginning at a Water Beech standing by the side of Little Geckaslungo Creek in the line of Hugh White's Land thence down the sd Creek 80 per to a post thence South 58 deg 8^{1/2} East 13 per to a post thence North 73 deg East 130 per to a post thence North 110 per to a Black Oak thence South 82 deg West 230 per to a Black Oak thence South East 79 per to the place of Beginning Containing One hundred & thirty one acres with the usual allowance of six acres p cent for Roads &c Surveyed the 25th day of April Anno Dom 1741
