



By Virtue of a warrant from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December Anno Domi 1739 Surveyed to Henry White a tract of land in Donegal Township & County of Lancaster Beginning at a Water Beech standing by the side of Little Seckasungo Creek in the line of Hugh White's Land thence down the s<sup>d</sup> Creek 80 per to a post thence South 58 Deg' 8 1/2 East 13 per to a post, thence North 73 Deg East 130 per to a post thence North 110 per to a Black Oak thence South 82 Deg West 230 per. to a Black Oak thence South East 79 per. to the place of Beginning, Containing One hundred & thirty one acres with the usual allowance of Six acres p Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> day of April Anno Domi 1741
