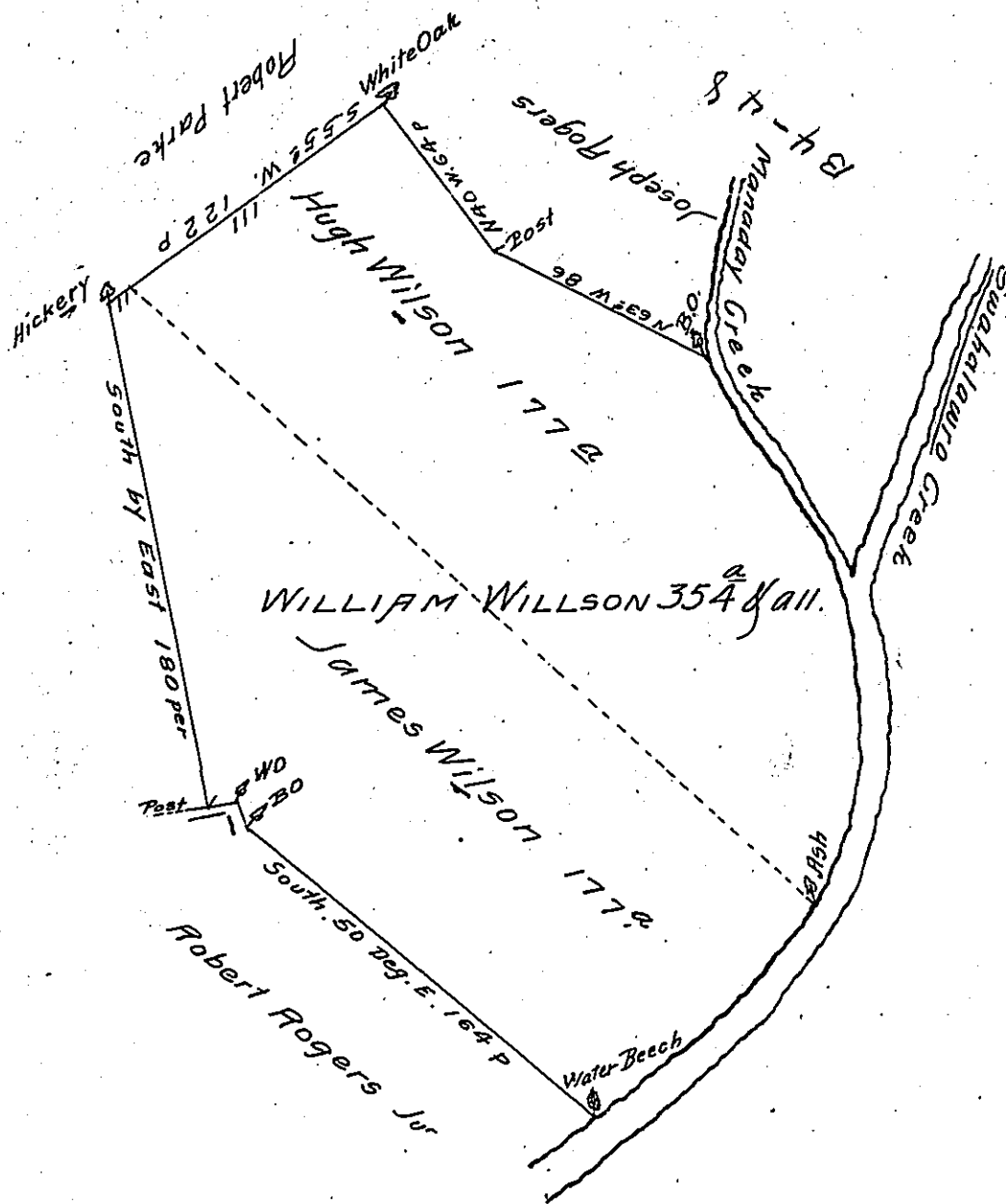


FORM NO 1.



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the 29th day of August Anno Domini 1737 The above described Tract of Land was surveyed unto William Willson in Hanover Township in the County of Lancaster. Begining at a Water Beech by Swatawra Creek then up the same on the several Courses thereof to ye mouth of Manaday Creek. Then up the same to a Black Oak. Then by ye Improvement of Joseph Rogers North 63 degrees West 86 perches to a post. Then North 40 degrees West 64 perches to a White Oak. Thence South 55 degrees west by Robert Parke 122 perches to a hickery Thence South by East by Vacant land 180 perches to a post. Then on ye lines of Robert Rogers Ju^r E. Nor. 82 D. East 10 p. to a White Oak South 28 Deg. East 9 per. to a Black Oak and South 50 degrees East 164 per to ye place of Begining. Containing Three hundred and fifty four acres beside ye all^o of 6 p Cent
