I have Resurveyed to James Wood a Water Lot Situate within the City of Philadelphia between Sassafras Street and Vine Street being part of a Bank and Water Lot formerly granted to Nathaniel Lamplugh containing in Breadth on Water Street and on the River Delaware Twent feet.

Bounded Westward with Water Street aforesaid Northward with ground of William Allen Esquire Eastward ward with the River Delaware at the extent of Two hundred and fifty feet from the East side of Front Street and Southward by other ground of the said James Wood
