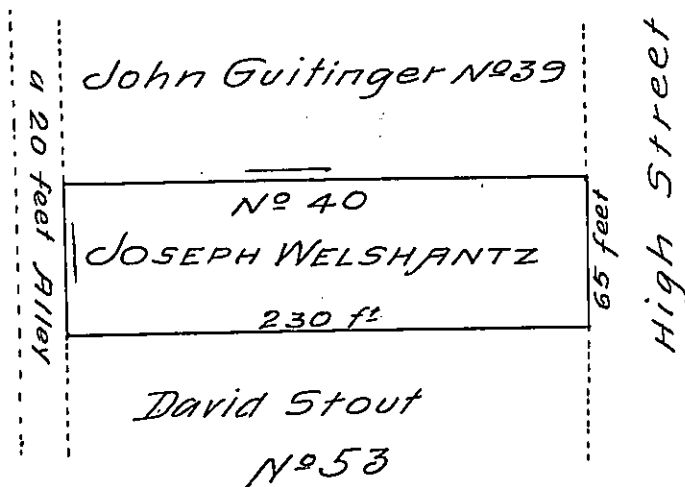


FORM No. 1.



A Plan of a Lot of Ground in the Town of York No 40. Situate on the North side of High Street. Containing in Breadth on the said High Street Sixty five feet, and in Length to a Twenty feet Alley Two hundred & Thirty feet. Bounded Southward with High Street. Westward with a Lot of Ground now in the tenure of David Stout No 53. Northward with a Twenty Feet Alley and Eastward with a Lot of Ground now in the tenure of John Guitinger No 39. Entered on the Plan of the said Town & Survey'd for Joseph Welshantz, who has built an House on the same Lot according to the Conditions of settling the Town. Certified at York the 15<sup>th</sup> day of Feb. 1753
