


FORM NO. 1.



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the third day of May 1733 Survey'd unto John White of the City of Philada<sup>a</sup> Merch<sup>t</sup> the 7<sup>th</sup> of the same month a tract of land situate in the County of Chester. Beginning at a post being a corner of Robert Green's land thence North by West by the same 163 pches to a post thence West 212 pches to a post thence South by East 163 pches to a post thence East 212 pches to the place of Beginning Containing Two hundred acres and the usual allowance for Roads.
