



The dotted line marked "A" shows line called for as the west line of the Thomas Craig lot owned by Detrick Rees, in the returns of the James Stewart and David Caldwell tracts. Said line has later been found and is admitted to be about 92 prs. farther easterly and 24 ps northerly than by those returns shown.

In above described lot there—cleared about one & a quarter acres cleared, balance unimproved. cleared shown by dotted lines.
