



A Draft of a tract of land situated in the Township of Wayne, and County of Clinton, containing One hundred and twenty five acres, ~~perches~~ and allowance of six percent for roads etc. Draughted for Jacob Quiggle and Robert C. Quiggle the seventh day of January 1902, it being part of a larger tract containing two hundred and twenty seven acres, sixty eight perches and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted Caty Sticker dated the eighteenth day of November 1793, and resurveyed Dec. 9. 1856 on order of Board of Property of June 28. 1856.
