



The above described Tracts of land are situate in Mo(obl.)ahan Township in the County of York. The (obliterated) & 93^{ps} was Surveyed (obl.) Month of April 1774 for John Logan, in pursuance of a Warr^t for 50^{ac} dated the 25th of March 1774. At the time of Survey, Logan, I believe, thought that he had included all the Vacancy; but since finding there was a Considerable Quanty more, desires that his Warr^t may be filled, and the Remainder left to Satisfy Andrew Wilsons 100^{ac} Warr^t dated the 13th of Aug^t 1774. I am of Opinion that Logan ought to have his Warr^t filled, doing a little Injury to Wilson as Possible, or at least a Proportionable ^{part} of the Whole. — There is a Considerable Quantity of the 103 1/4^{ac} Cleared ^{by Wilson} which was done some years before either of the Warrants were Granted. Submit the Matter to the Hon. Board of Property.
