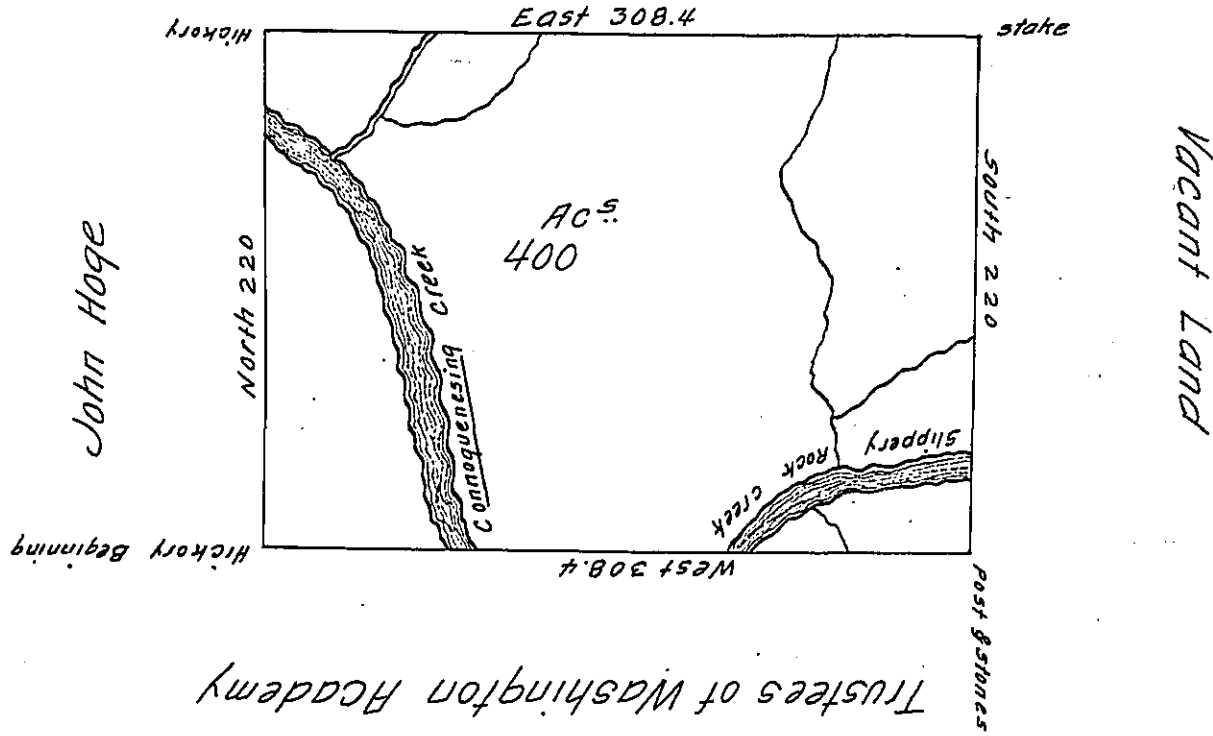

The above is a Draught of a Survey made Novemb^r. 12th 1793 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to the Washington Academy for 3.000 Acres of Land in Separate Tracts ^{Dated the 9th of August 1793} Situate North Westward of the Rivers Ohio and Allegheny. on Connoguenesing and Slippery Rock Creeks (Adj^d a Tract Surveyed for Said Trustees. Called horse Shoe flat) in District N^o. 10. Called Round Bottom. Containing four Hundred Acres together with the Usual Allowance of Six p^{ct} for Roads.
