



The above is a Draught of a Survey made November the 14th 1793. in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to the Trustees of Washington Academy for 3,000 Acres of Land. Dated the 9th Day of August 1793. Situate North Westward of the Rivers Ohio and Allegheny on the Waters of Connequenesing Creek in District N^o 10. Called Mount Pleasant. (Adjoining a Tract of Land Survey'd for Said Trustees Called Black Oak Ridge) Containing four hundred Acres of Land together with the Usual Allowance of Six p^r Cent for Roads.
