



The above is a Draught of a Survey made November 13th 1793. in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to the Trustees of Washington Academy for 3,000 Acres of Land in Separate Tracts. Dated the 9th Day of August 1793. Situate North West ward of the Rivers Ohio and Allegheny on the Waters of Connequenesing Creek in District No 10. Called "Arcadia" ~~White Pool~~. (Adj^g a Tract of Land Surveyed for Said Trustees Called Round Bottom) Containing four hund Acres together with the Usual Allowance of Six p^{ct} Cent for Roads.
