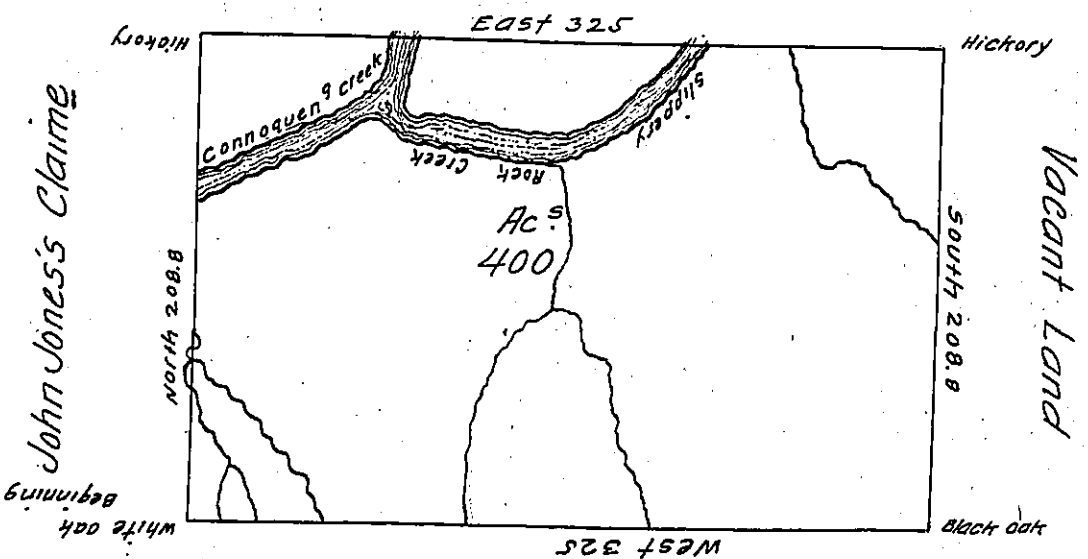


Trustees of Washington Academy



Vacant Land

The above is a Draught of a Survey made November 12th 1793. in pursu-
 ance of a Warrant Granted to the Washington Academy for 3,000 Acres
 of Land in Separate Tracts, Dated the 9th of August 1793, Situate North Westward of the Rivers
 Ohio and Allegheny including the forks of Connequenesing and Slippery
Rock Creeks in District N^o 10. Called horse Shoe flat. Containing four hun-
 dred Acres together with the Usual Allowance of Six p^{ct}. Cent for Roads.
