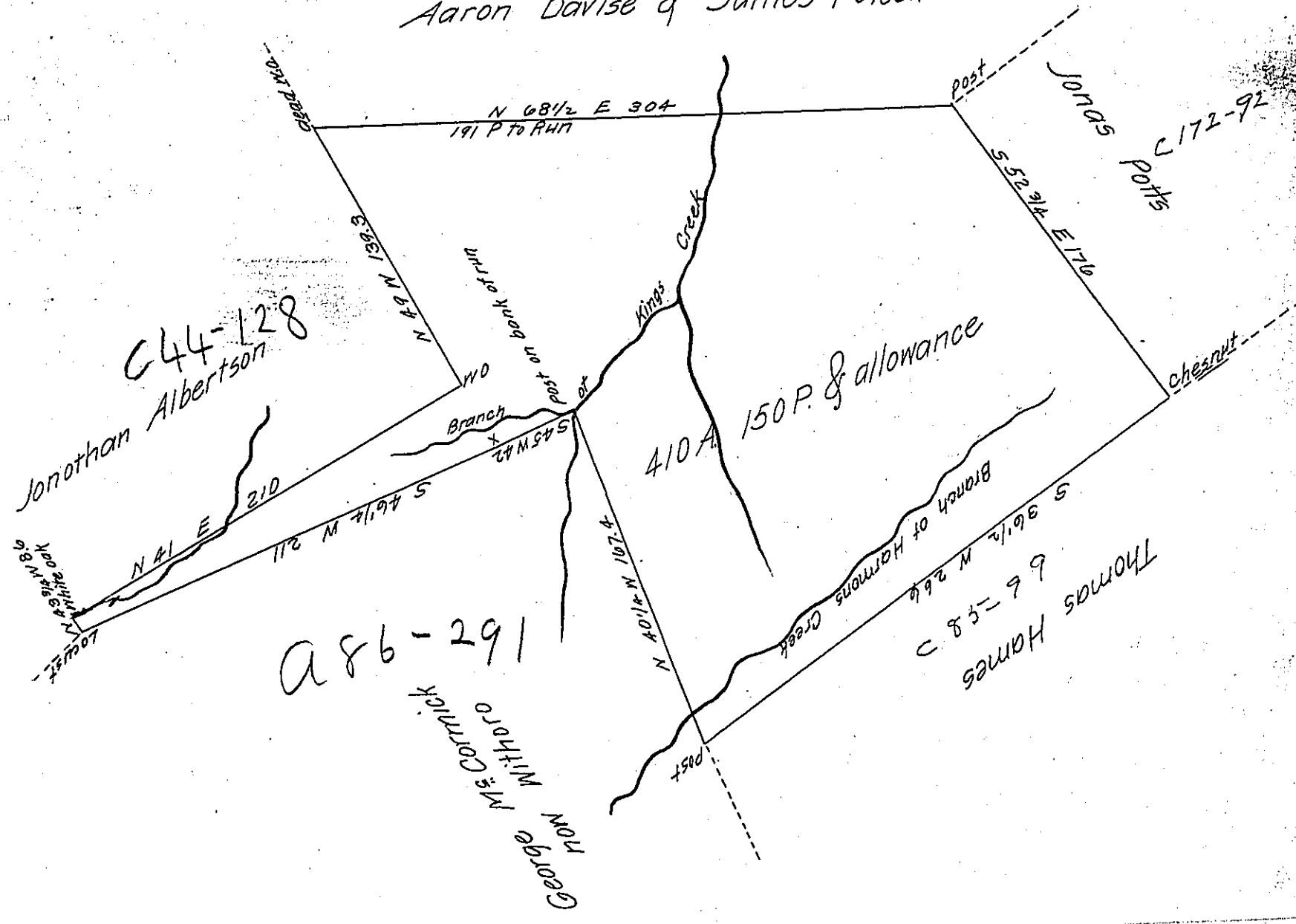


Aaron Davise & James Pollock



A draught of a tract of land surveyed February 17<sup>th</sup> 1812 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Tucker for 400 acres dated January 4<sup>th</sup> 1788 situate in Hanover township on the dividing ridge between Kings & Harmens Creek (Called grace) containing four hundred and ten acres and one hundred and fifty perches and allowance of six per Cent for roads &c
