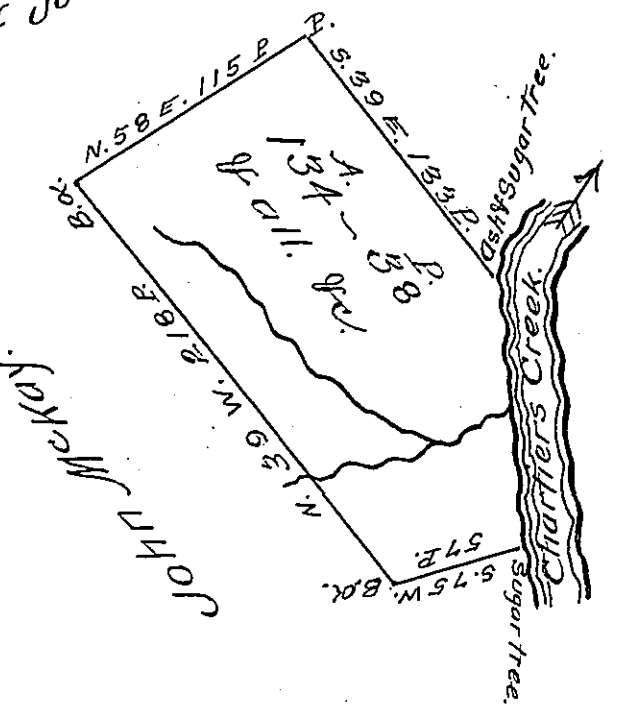


Heirs of Joseph Pierce.

The above is a draft of a tract of land situate on the west side of Chartiers creek in Moon Township Allegheny County, surveyed on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of October 1806 for Joseph White and Philip O'Hara in pursuance of a warrant granted to them bearing date the 27<sup>th</sup> June 1806, containing one hundred and thirty four acres and thirty eight perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
