



The above Tract of land was Originally Surveyed on the 24th day of October 1775 by George Palmer Esquire Deputy of Northampton Co. In pursuance of a warrant dated the 2nd March 1775. Granted to Alexander Van Gorden and Ludwick Hover, and on the 8th day of Feb^ry 1816, Resurveyed and divided the same as the above Draft shows to Alexander Van Gorden, and return half ^{his} part for Berj^s Custard now Garret Bradhead. Containing Sixty acres thirty four perches and allowance of Six P^r C^t for Roads &c^s.
