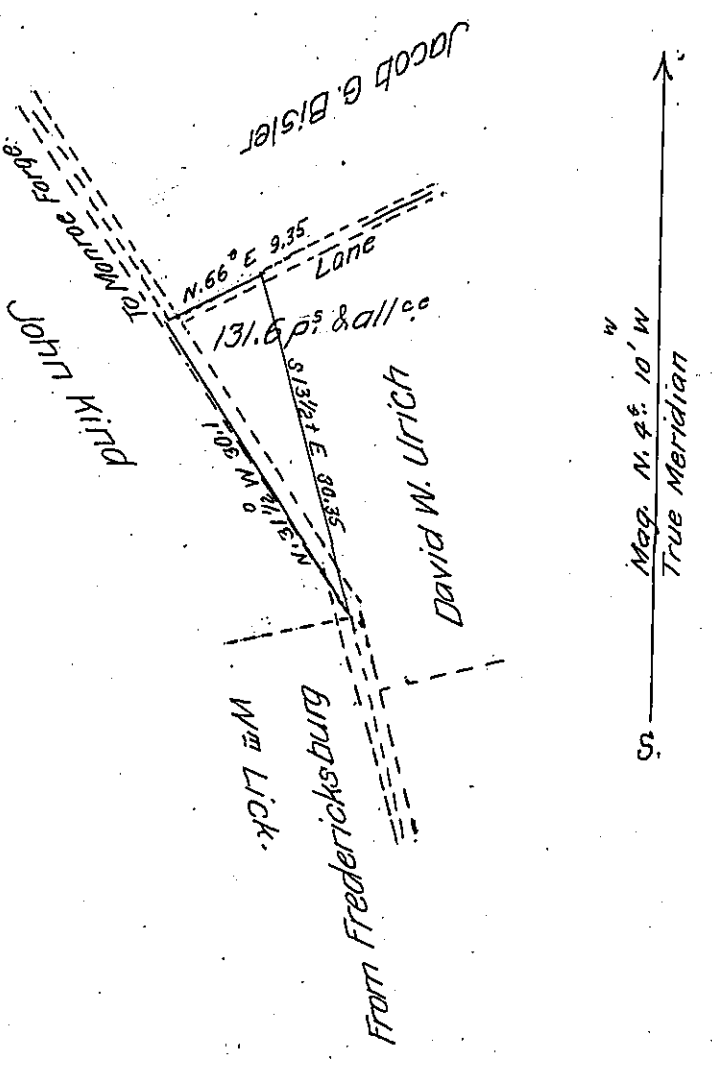

(equal to 139.5 perches st. measure)
