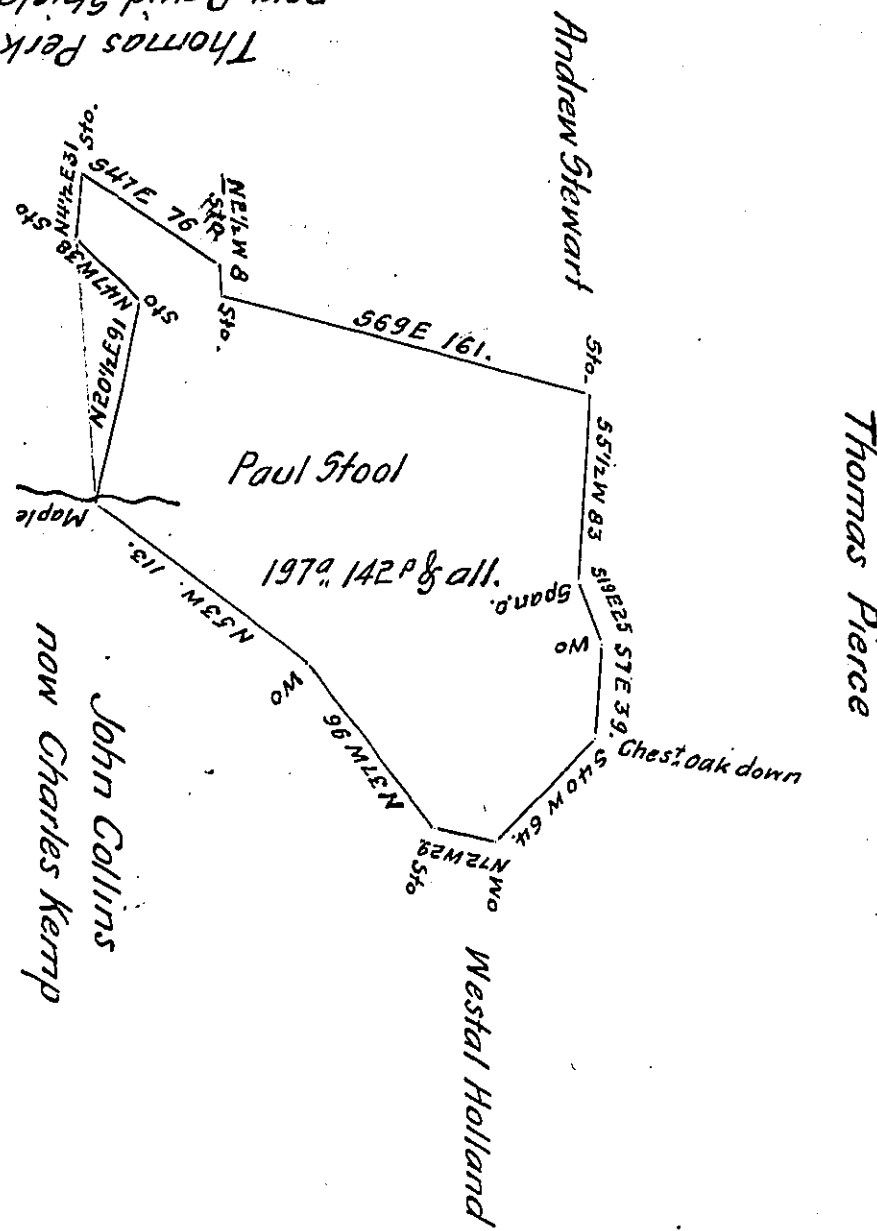


Thomas Perkins

Situate in Wharton Township Fayette County and Surveyed by William Griffith late Deputy Surveyor for Fayette County on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1837. in pursuance of a warrant granted to Paul Stool dated May 5<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1795 for one hundred and ninety seven acres and one hundred and forty two perches and allowance on which there is an improvement about 50 acres cleared a house and stable has been improved 40 years and now in the occupancy of Greenberry Bosby

I hereby certify the above to be a true copy of a survey made by William Griffith late Deputy Surveyor for Fayette County given under my hand this 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 1851
