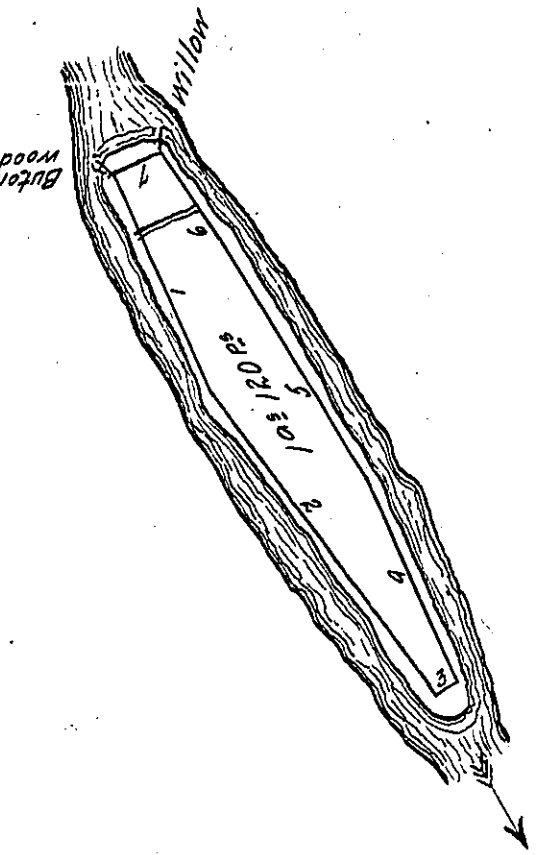


Draft of an Island Situate in the Conewango creek

 hundred & twenty perches being the fourth below the one  
 about opposite Asa Winter near the West Shore about a mile  
 from the mouth. Surveyed for Arch<sup>d</sup> Tanner on his Warrent  
 Granted him 5<sup>th</sup> May A.D. 1828 for one acre one hundred  
 & twenty perches, July 3<sup>d</sup> A.D. 1828.
