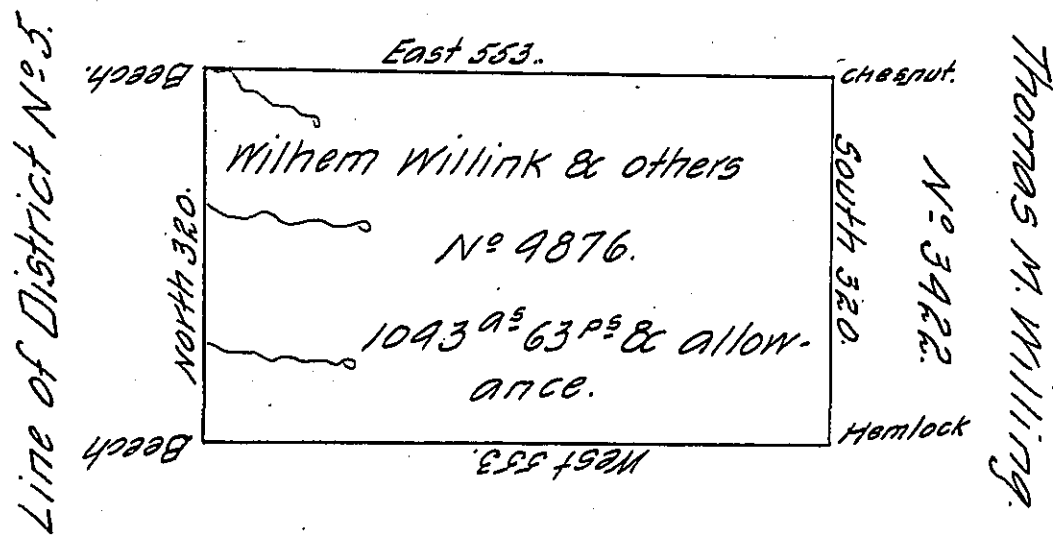

Dated the third day of February 1794.
