

By Warrant to Wilhem Willink Nicholaas Van Staphorst Pieter Stadnitski Christiaan Van Eeghen Hindrick Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam No 4914. Dated the third day of February 1794.
